These dates will be your best opportunity to school over the cross-country jumps before the May Mini-event and the October Horse Trials! Some of these jumps are in a locked animal pasture and inaccessible except on the above dates. You will have access to jumps of all levels: Intro, Beg. Novice, Novice, Training and Preliminary. We will have the grass mowed around all the jumps and we will provide you with maps of the courses. Additionally, the multi-level water complex will be filled and we have a multi-level bank complex open, as well. We will have hoses hooked up for the horses.

You may sign up and pay on the schooling day, but we strongly prefer sign-up and payment in advance, as we must have at least 10 pre-payments before each schooling day or they are subject to cancellation. We understand you may not know until shortly before each schooling day if you are coming or not.

- You may school each fence as often as needed, but please be considerate of other riders.
- Hard hats with chin harness are required at all times for minors, and for adults if jumping.
- Safety vests are strongly recommended!
