In all classes except English pleasure, horsemanship/equitation, costume and game/speed events, western attire is required including short or long sleeve shirt (to the wrist) collared shirt, hat, and **BOOTS required.** (**Tank tops and halters are not allowed.**)

For personal safety, it is recommended that protective helmets be used in speed events but not required.

HELMETS ARE ENCOURAGED FOR THE PEE WEE AND SPEED CLASSES.
