### Blue Ribbon - Saddles, Headstalls & Spurs

Novice Youth, Novice Amateur, 13 & under Youth, 14-18 Youth, Amateur, Select & Open Blue Ribbon Saddles for the winners – can only win ONE saddle per family & horse. See office for complete rules & rotation of awards. Small Fry All-Around also three places – special awards for this division.

Must show halter in your respective division(s) to qualify. (Small Fry excluded.)

Conflicts between arenas will be handled. Just let the gate people know.

### *Jerry Wells Memorial Open & Amateur Yearling Halter Futurity*

\$250 entry fee per class – held concurrently with the corresponding AQHA class.

100% of the entry fee jackpotted – ROTH Show Halters to the winners.
