Classes may be added up to 1 class prior.

No Ponying in poles or barrels—classes #4 & #9, helpers may enter arena but must not interfere with judge

Scratches will not be refunded without a vet excuse.

** MODEL CLASSES may use a halter or bridle-unsaddled horse-all entries enter arena at one time in one line and line up for judge to judge CONFORMATION only**horses that are not gaited are considered STOCK

Show will not refund for classes incorrectly chosen.

Stallions must be handled by exhibitors 18 yrs. & over.
