### *From the East:*

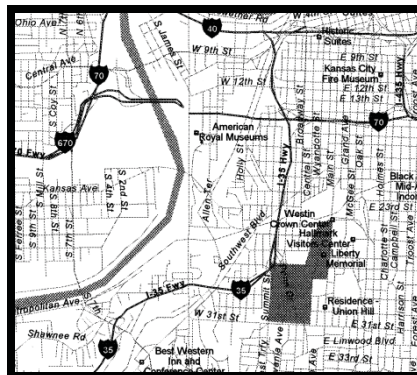

LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING, AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30 NON-MEMBER REGISTRATION FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE; 1)LEADLINE; 2)EXHIBITIONS; 3)GAMES AND RACES; 4)CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5)WALK TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6)USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7)NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS; 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES; 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION; 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.

Exhibitors are requested to thoroughly acquaint themselves with the following rules and regulations. Exhibitors participating in divisions recognized by the USEF will also be governed by this prize list. Any changes in the current USEF rule book will automatically become a part of this prize list. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

All exhibitors are required to be thoroughly acquainted with any and all federal and state laws and regulations governing horses and horse shows. The American Royal Association, Inc., reserves the right to decline any exhibitor and/or said exhibitor's horses before the show and reserves the right to order from the premises during the show any exhibitor and/or exhibitor's horses without being held liable for damages of any kind, and this shall be accepted as a condition of entry. In this event, all fees paid and prize money won shall be forfeited. It is also a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the American Royal Association, Inc, its directors and employees, and the UPHA, its directors and employees, harmless for any loss, damage or accident to horses or equipment.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2)exhibitions; 3)games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

**FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT**

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Germantown Charity Horse Show. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

***Important: Horses placing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> in each qualifying class must show back in their respective championship class or forfeit their prize money.***

The Liberty class is a jackpot class. This class will offer a purse of 2/3 of all entry fees in this class.

Payback in classes with less than five horses will be as follows:

Five horses pay back to 3<sup>rd</sup> place

Four horses pay back to 2<sup>nd</sup> place

Three horses pay back to first place

There will be no payback in equitation, showmanship, lead line and championship halter classes, supreme halter championship classes.

Ribbons will be awarded to 8<sup>th</sup> place in Equitation and Championship Classes.



## RULES AND REGULATIONS

**Entries close on September 13.** All entries must be post marked by this date. Entries will be accepted after this date with a one-time late charge of \$25.00 per horse. Horses entered in the show may enter additional classes without a post entry penalty.

**Deadline** for entering classes are as follows:

8:00 pm for next morning classes

One hour prior to session start for all afternoon and evening classes.

**Arrival Time-** Thursday, September 20 not before noon

**Departure time-** Monday, September 24 by 8:00 AM

**Entries** must be made under full registered name and a copy of registration papers, copy of the USEF and AHA membership cards for the owner, trainer, driver, and rider/handler must accompany the entry. Horses must be able to show proper registration.

The American Royal Arabian Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Arabian Horse Division. The premium list is based on the rules of the current Rule Book. Any changes or corrections of the rules will automatically become part of this premium list. Each participant in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to USEF rules. Questions not covered by the USEF rules shall be decided by the show committee and its decision will be final. This is a "A" rated show by the United States Equestrian Federation and approved by the AHA

**Accounting or Bookkeeping:** The owner of a horse is responsible for the liability to the show. NSF checks are presented twice. If the check is still NSF after the second presentation, it is automatically turned over for collection. This is an automatic banking system procedure. The American Royal reserves the right to charge a \$50.00 NSF fee.

**AHA Membership Requirements:** Owner, trainer, riders, drivers and handlers must be current members of AHA at the time of entry and showing. If one of the owners, trainers, riders, drivers or handlers is not members, they are subject to an AHA non-member fee.

**The American Royal Association, Inc.** reserves the right to decline any exhibitor and/or said exhibitor's horses before the show and reserves the right to order from the premises during the show any exhibitor and/or exhibitor's horses without being held liable for damages of any kind. This shall be accepted as a condition of entry. In this event, all fees paid and prize money won shall be forfeited. It is also a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the American Royal Association, Inc., its directors and employees harmless for any loss, damage or accident to horses or equipment.

**Camper and Mobile home Space:** *Camper Space must be reserved and paid for online: [www.americanroyal.com](http://www.americanroyal.com)*

**Courtesy:** Any discourteous act on the part of an owner, exhibitor, groom, trainer, or agent made toward judges, officials or other exhibitors will disqualify the entry and they will forfeit all fees and premiums. The Horse Show Committee shall have full power to act in issuing a ruling in such cases. Should the act justify it, the Horse Show Committee shall have power to exclude offender(s) from competition and remove them from the show grounds without being held liable for damages of any kind and this shall be accepted as a condition of the entry.

**Dogs:** Dogs are not allowed in the Hale or Kemper Arenas. Dogs in stable area are required to be on a leash.

**Entries:** Entries must be made on an American Royal Horse Arabian Show Entry Form signed by the owner, exhibitor, rider, driver, handler and trainer.

**Feed and Bedding:**

***Due to rising costs regarding disposal of stall bedding materials, exhibitors are asked to purchase shavings and straw on site. Bulk deliveries of shavings will not be allowed. Thank you for your understanding.*** Feed, grain, hay, straw and shavings are available through the Feed Room. Orders must be placed between 7:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. ***Feed and Bedding will be billed through the horse show office.*** Electrical Adaptors may be picked up in the Feed and Bedding office located in far-southwest corner of "Hale" stabling area. During the show, the Feed Room phone number is: 816.513.4107.

**BEDDING:**

Shavings: \$9/bag  
Straw: \$ 7/bale

**Fees:** All fees must be paid in full and accompany an entry form. No post-dated checks will be accepted. During the show, an open check may be left in the office for additional fees incurred during the show.

**Footing:** Hale Arena (Show Arena) is 110' x 205' and will be available after show hours for exercise with limited lighting in the evening hours. The Tom Bass Arena, (Warm-up Arena) is 140' x 300' will also be available. All arena and schooling arenas are a combination of screened sand and dirt.

**Liberty Class:** Liberty is limited to 6 entries. This will be accepted on a first come basis. Horses will be shown with halters on. Horses will have 2 minutes to perform and 2 minutes to be caught. Music may be provided, and must be submitted to the show office prior to the show. Open to Half Arabians and Purebred Arabians.



**Minors:**

7. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. ***The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation.*** Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**Ownership Requirements:** The ownership of all horses entered in the show must be clearly stated on the entry form. Copies of registration must be included with submission of entry.

**Premium Payment:** Premiums will be paid by check no later than 30 days after the show. Horses placing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in qualifying classes must show back in the respective championship class or forfeit their winnings.

**Refund:** Request for refunds must be received in horse show office with a veterinarian certificate to receive refund. Office fee is non refundable. Vet outs are subject to a 40.00 vet out fee.

**RIDING AREAS:** All arenas/school areas are a combination of sifted sand/dirt.

**ARENA DIMENSIONS:**

Hale Arena –120' X 220'  
Tom Bass Arena – 125' x 225'

**Stalls:** Box stalls are portable vinyl (9 ½' x 9 ½' ) with doors. Stalls will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis with exception to Premium Stalls. No bedding is furnished with stalls. No reservations for stalls can be made without full payment. **Premium stalls are a one-time \$150 charge to ensure an aisle location.**

**Supreme Halter Championship Classes:** The Supreme Halter class is only for Champion and Reserve Champion horses and any first place horses that are not eligible to show back in a Junior or Grand Champion class. These classes will be judged utilizing a comparative judging system, rather than the point system. There are no entry fees for these classes.

**Training Aids:** Whips longer than 6 feet are not allowed at ringside or warm-up areas. Fire extinguishers will be confiscated and offenders will be reported to USEF. No attention-getting devices allowed in warm-up ring or show ring.

**Trophies:** All memorial, perpetual and challenge trophies will remain in the possession of the American Royal. Souvenir trophies will be awarded for permanent possession.

**Truck and Trailer Parking:** Exhibitors enter through Gate A on the west side of the American Royal Building (southwest corner of complex) Trailers must be parked in appropriate area during the show.

## 2012 AHA Medal Class Specifications

### **AHA Saddle Seat Medal Class.**

- a. In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF Tests (EQ 120) 1 – 15 (EC equivalent). Markers shall not be used. USEF Test 16 may only be called for at the National Shows.

### **AHA Reining Seat Medal Class.**

- a. All contestants are required to perform a Reining patten as outlined I USEF Reining Division (EC Equivalent)
- b. Order of go will be done by draw.
- c. Bits must be dropped an inspected by the Judge or designated official, and all riders must dismount for this inspection. If called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary, may be had from one of the ring officials.
- d. Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits.
- e. In the event the total score is tied, the tie will first be broken by the exhibitor with the highest equitation score. Should a tie still exist, the tie shall be broken by reining rules in RN 103.2.

### **AHA Western Horsemanship Medal Class.**

- a. In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform a minimum for four test from the USEF Arabian, Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Division, Subchapter Western Horsemanship, AR-26.


