From Hwy 65, take 160 east towards Forsyth. Approximately 4 miles east of Forsyth, 160 turn right, turn right staying on 160. Go 13 miles further, turn right on Frank Rea Road. It's a sharp right but you can swing in alright. Go 3 miles down to parking, watch for signs.

Registration starts at 7:30am; walk thru at 8:15am, race starts at 9am.

Come join us on Saturday June 30<sup>th</sup> for a day of fun and challenges! We are setting up a three acre course to challenge both horses and riders. That's the main course. The course for buckaroos, youth, novices, and classic riders will be in a smaller area, but will be just as much fun! Taney County Riding Club will have concessions for sale including lunch, drinks, and snacks, with all profits benefiting Taney County Riding Club. There are restrooms on site, and water for horses will be available. If you are interested in showing up the evening before the race, primitive campsites and horse pens can be reserved on a call-ahead basis.

The ranch backs up to the lovely Mark Twain National Forest and is approximately 45 minutes from downtown Branson. The nearest town is Forsyth, about 25 minutes away and has all the amenities a small town can offer: 3 fast food restaurants, groceries, gas stations, and several locally owned specialty restaurants.

For those of you who have considered joining UHCA or other "extreme" riding events, we'll have judged practice runs for anyone for \$15/rider at the conclusion of the last division of riders. Although there is no payback or awards, you can see how you would rate. Our hope is that you will fall in love with it and want to join the Association! Of course if you join before the races begin, and enter a race, your points will start accumulating immediately for the UHCA 4 Corners Region 2012 Awards. If you want to race in one of the classes, but not join, there is an additional \$10 fee for non-members.

Entry Fees are as follows (with 50% Payback in Classic, Colt, Amateur, and Open):

Buckaroos (ages 5-11) \$25

Colt (3-4 yr old horses) \$50

Youth (ages 12-17) \$30

Amateur (18 and up, see rules) \$60

Novice (have never won \$\$) \$40

Open \$70

Classic (Ages 55 and over) \$40

Add \$10 to entries for non-members
