GENERAL RULES

- A. Current Negative Coggins or Out of State Papers is required to be presented for all horses showing or entering the Warren County Fairgrounds for any event. No stallions allowed on grounds.
- B. All horses will be properly controlled at all times, both in and out of the arena and will not be ridden to the endangerment of anyone and should be properly trained for the classes. Any unsportsman like conduct or mistreatment of any animal will result in disqualification and forfeiture of all entries and will be asked to leave the fairground. All horses must stay in designated area.
- C. All participants under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian present on grounds at all times. All parent or guardians are responsible for their children, horses and equipment.
- D. Show is open to **youth age 20 and under as of July 2, 2013.**
- E. Western attire is required for ALL classes. Western attire is defined as boots, western shirt, and hat or safety helmets. (NO ball caps, tank tops, shorts or tennis shoes are allowed in any class); Hat is not required for game classes.
- F. Only one entry in each class per rider/horse combination and entries will close one class prior to current class in arena.
- G. A two-minute gate will be in effect per class after class has entered arena. PLEASE BE READY ON TIME.
- H. A five second penalty for each overturned barrel in the barrel race, and each overturned pole in the pole bending, No time given for broken pattern in all games or if flag is dropped in flag race. **No reins, whips, romels, or bats to be used in any class.**
- I. For participants age 14 & over, there will be a high point belt buckle awarded to top rider/horse combination. Points will be awarded on the 4-H Showmanship & Horsemanship Classes and all game classes. To be considered for the high point buckle participants must list the High Point Class on their entry form and designate which horse that will be used for high point. (Note: You will want to enter your high point horse in class #3,9,11,13,15,17,19, & 21)
- J. Entry fees will not be refunded.
- K. All disputes will need to be brought before the "show committee" and a decision will be made.
