ATTENTION DRESSAGE EXHIBITORS

Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct applicable numbers (USDF and USEF) for horse, owner, rider, and trainer, before the day(s) of the competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.

USDF Membership Benefits: USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the USDF Member Guide or the USDF website at www.usdf.org.

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or ownerlesssee, must have either a USDF Group Membership, Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF NM fee. (Note: USDF business members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF BMA.) Individuals cannot compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition with a USDF Education Membership.

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux, quadrilles, FEI Paso-Equestrian classes, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy and opportunity classes.
- Riders and ownerlesssees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are transfers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$70), 3-years (\$200), or life (\$1,500). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$60). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or ownerlesssee for all Adequan[®]USDF Year-End Awards, Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders' Championship Series Finals and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$200) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Education Membership (EM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. This online education only membership expires 12 months after the date joined. This membership type does NOT allow an individual to compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM ownerlesssee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$25 and a USDF NM form per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF along with the USDF Reg of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Ownerlesssees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF member there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be involved for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report filing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$25). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded, but will NOT be counted toward Adequan[®]USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes or Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders' Championship Series Finals. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$70. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$95) is eligible for Adequan[®]USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders' Championship Series Finals and Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.

SHOW OFFICE: Located off the main lobby. The show office will open Thursday afternoon and remain open until approximately 9p.m. The show office will close 15 minutes prior to each session and will reopen and remain open throughout each session unless otherwise posted or announced.

ENTRIES CLOSE: February 22nd, 2013. Entries postmarked after this date, received by mail after Feb. 28th, 2013, **or entered at the show** will be charged post entry fees of \$5.00 per class. **All entries made at the show, regardless of pre-entry, will be charged post entry fees.** Mail entries complete with signed entry blank, fee payment (NO BLANK/TAB CHECKS) and all photocopies of membership cards and registration certificates to Show Secretary.

THERE WILL BE AN ADDITIONAL \$10.00 CHARGE FOR EACH INCOMPLETE ENTRY. Entries lacking any of the above mentioned, will be considered incomplete and may be returned. Exhibitor packets will not be given to exhibitors until entry is complete. All entries must be accompanied by a valid check or money order for the full amount of all fees made out to MAHA. **THERE WILL BE AN ADDITIONAL 25.00 CHARGE FOR ANY CHECK RETURNED FOR ANY REASON. THERE WILL BE A \$25.00 FEE FOR STOP PAYMENT OF CHECK FOR ANY REASON.**

Entries will only be considered complete if copies of each of the following are sent with Entry Form:

- A. Horse's Registration Certificate
- B. Proof of Ownership (if applicable)**
- C. USEF Membership Cards (owner, trainer, rider, driver & handler)
- D. AHA Competition Membership Cards (owner, trainer, rider, driver & handler)
- E. USEF Amateur Certification (if applicable)
- F. Check for Total Entry written to MAHA--NO BLANK CHECKS ACCEPTED!

*A copy of both the ownership side (and pedigree side for purebred Arabians) of the current registration certificate of each horse entered must be sent along with the entry form to the Show Secretary, or be presented in the show office for post entries.

** In the case of a sale or lease, it is required that a copy of the sale contract or lease, or statement from the owner be submitted with the copy of the current registration certificate. Exhibitors showing in Amateur Owner classes must be listed as an owner of the horse they are exhibiting.

All entries must be made in writing on an official entry form for this show or photocopies of the same. Please use a ballpoint pen or typewriter to complete entry form. Every owner, trainer, rider, driver, handler and parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor must sign the entry form and must be a member of USEF and AHA Competition Member or pay the nonmember/single event fees. A horse may be entered in the name of his recorded owner or lessee only. The complete address and phone number of the recorded owner or lessee must be given, even if an agent enters the horse. All horses belonging to one owner must be entered on one entry form. No horses may be entered on more than one form. There will be no "Ride Throughs" allowed.

Management reserves the right to limit class sizes and passes through the gate and number of Dressage rides per day.

Post Entries

Post entries may be made providing an additional fee of \$5.00 per class is paid. Post entries and additional class entries for afternoon and evening sessions must be received before the conclusion of the preceding session. Post entries and additional class entries for morning sessions should be made before the end of the last session on the day preceding the class. No post entries accepted for dressage unless to fill scratches only. **All classes entered at the show, regardless of pre-entries, will be charged post entry fees.**

Withdrawing Entries & Refunds

Entries may be scratched from the show prior to February 22nd, 2013 with a total refund of all fees. After the entry closing date, a refund of class fees will be made only if a written request accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate is received in the show office by 5:00 p.m., March 14th, 2013. There will be a \$25.00 fee for stop payment of a check when withdrawing entries. If check is not made good, AHA & USEF will be notified and appropriate action will be taken. As a courtesy to other exhibitors and show management, **EACH EXHIBITOR IS REQUIRED TO CANCEL ALL CLASSES THEIR HORSE WILL NOT BE COMPETING IN SO THE GATE WILL NOT BE HELD FOR THEM.** A penalty of \$10.00 per class will be charged to all exhibitors who fail to notify management of class cancellations.

Registration Requirements

Horses shown in the Arabian Division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association and must be entered under their full registered name. Horses shown in the Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association in the Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Registry and entered under their registered name.

INDEMNITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

All entries are made and accepted with the understanding that the Missouri Arabian Horse Association will not be responsible for any loss, personal injury, or damage to any horse exhibited or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or in any way damaged and each participant assumes the risk of any such injury and recognizes that participation in activities involving horses is inherently risky. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, or any animal, or any property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify the Missouri Arabian Horse Association against any and all loss, liability and damages of any kind or nature thus occasioned, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance of each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth."

AHA Competition Level Membership Requirements:

Every owner, trainer, driver, rider, driver and handler must have a valid AHA Competition membership card. Current Competition Level Membership is required for all owners, trainers, riders, drivers & handlers or a Single Event Membership must be purchased for \$35 per person. Membership not required for Lead Line, Walk/Trot, or Showmanship 10 & Under classes.

USEF Statement:

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee and a \$30 nonmember Amateur card fee to participate in ATR classes. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

Missouri State Health Requirements

An official health certificate issued within 30 days of the show by a licensed veterinarian must accompany all horses not residing in the State of Missouri. A negative Coggins certificate issued within the past 12 months must accompany all horses. The health and original Coggins certificates must be available for inspection at the time of check in. Do not mail with your entry. In case of suspected unsoundness or as a safeguard against communicable disease, all horses are subject to physical inspection by the show veterinarian.

Stabling: Those exhibitors wishing to be stalled together must send all entries, with the correct fees, together in the same envelope. ALL HORSES ENTERED MUST HAVE A STALL. NO SHOWING OUT OF TRAILERS. All stalls are permanent 10X10 stalls with doors and are under cover. No stalls will be reserved without payment. All horses stalled must be entered in the show. Hay and grain will be available at Hawk Ridge Feed and Pet, located adjacent to the Equestrian Center. Phone number 636-561-6637. Bedding must be purchased from the National Equestrian Center. Minimum two bales are required per stall.

Arrival Time: Horses will be accepted Thursday, March 14th after 9:00 am. Anyone who wants to arrive before this time should advise the barn manager of your arrival date and time. There will be an additional charge of \$25.00 per day per horse for early arrivals. The barn manager will post stall assignments near the show office. All stall doors are locked and will be opened by the barn manager upon your arrival.

Departure Time: All horses must depart the show grounds no later than midnight, Sunday, March 17th. Exhibitors wanting to remain after this time must make special arrangements with the barn manager and will be charged an additional fee of \$25.00 per day per stall.

Arenas: The show will be held in two (2) separate indoor arenas, which have excellent heated facilities for both the horse and rider. The main show arenas are 120'x240' with a dirt/sand mixture footing. The adjoining warm-up arenas are 100'x200' with a dirt/sand mixture footing. Exhibitors will be permitted to work horses in the indoor ring between sessions up to one-half hour prior to the start of the session at which time the ring will be closed for show preparation. The show arenas will be open for working horses on Thursday, March 14th at 12:00 noon and will remain open each day until midnight and will reopen for showing the following day. **Jumping will be held in the outdoor arena adjacent to the Dressage Arena.** The outdoor arena has an all-weather sand footing and is 170' x 240'. **Schooling over Jumps will be Friday March 15th, 2013.**

Campers & Horse Trailers:

Complete camping facilities and showers are located near the show arena. Advance reservations are not required. The fairgrounds personnel will collect fees daily at the rate of \$30 per night. No vehicles of any kind will be allowed in the arena, paddock or schooling areas. In operating any vehicles, please be aware of safety rules and have consideration for horses, exhibitors and spectators.

Dogs: Your dogs are welcome at our show. Since we also welcome children, please remember to keep your dogs contained or on a leash at all times for the safety of the children, horses, and your dog. The warm-up ring and show arena building are off-limits for our canine friends.

Protests: Any protest must be filed in accordance with USEF Rules and/or AHA Code of Ethics rules.

Officials: In the event that an official is unable to perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute an official according to USEF rules. Any tie in a jumping class will be broken by the judge. Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, groom, rider, driver or handler will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove the horse's owner, groom, rider, driver, and/or handler from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

Calls for Classes: Classes will be called promptly. First call when second class ahead enters the ring; second call when preceding class enters the ring; third call while ribbons are being awarded in the preceding class. Two minutes will be allowed after the first horse in the class enters the ring, after which the gate will be closed. If tack changes are necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to notify the gateman and request a three minute gate hold. The public address system and class calls are a courtesy. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their horses at the gate at the prescribed time.

Protective Headgear: Riders in all classes where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the show grounds, must wear protective headgear. Refer to current USEF Rule Book GR 318 & GRI401.30.

Motorized Vehicles: NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES ALLOWED ON THE NEC GROUNDS. (Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this). Any minor operating a vehicle on the competition grounds must have a valid driver's license issued by their State of residence. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

SPLIT CLASSES

In Driving classes of over 9 horses and in Performance and Halter classes of over 23 horses, the class will be split and will be designated Section A and Section B. A rider/handler/driver may participate in both sections with different horses. In Junior Exhibitor 18 & Under classes, if there are at least five entries aged 13 & Under and five entries aged 14-18, the classes will be split and designated Section A-13 & Under and Section B-14-18.

OPTION CLASSES: Option classes will be held on a first come/first served basis if the sponsorship fee of \$25 plus regular class entry fee (no post to apply) is paid. Send the request with your entry or you can make your request in the show office. There will be no late entry fees for any horse entered in an Option class.

JT (R,D,H) Junior to Ride, Drive, Handle

JOT (R,D,H) Junior Owner to Ride, Drive, Handle

AAT (R,D,H) Adult Amateur to Ride, Drive, Handle

- **Select Rider:** See AHA Handbook for new definition of Select Riders under AR 113.

- **Maiden, Novice and Limit Horse Classes**

Maiden, Novice and Limit classes are open to horses or riders that have not won one/three/six first place ribbons respectively at USEF Regular Member Competitions in the particular performance section shown prior to the closing date of entries.

- Walk Trot--Pleasure & Equitation Riders may not enter any other performance class in this show, except Lead Line, and/or Showmanship. No payback, except in Walk Trot Championship classes.
- Jumping Classes Order of Go will be posted in the office prior to the first session and will be selected at random. All ties in jumping classes will be broken by Judge. There will be no Working Hunter Championship class.

PERFORMANCE DIVISION

The first four place winners of all classes marked with an "*" must show back in the corresponding championship class or forfeit all prize money won in qualifying classes. To be eligible for Championship classes, horse must have been entered, shown and judged in any class in that division. There will be no payback for Walk/Trot Performance or Walk/Trot Equitation classes.

HALTER DIVISION

First two place winners of all halter classes must show back in the corresponding championship class if eligible. Sport Horse Halter In-Hand classes will use the triangle pattern.

DRESSAGE/SPORT HORSE DIVISION

The 2011 USDF/USEF Dressage Tests will be used. Sport Horse in Hand classes will use the Triangle pattern. Refer to USEF Subchapter AR-12. Open to Arabians/Half-Arabians/Anglo-Arabians. Dressage and In Hand Entries will be accepted on a first come/first served basis. Post entries for Dressage and In Hand will be accepted to fill scratched classes, and under the same rules as govern other performance classes. Dressage classes will not necessarily run on the posted day or in Prize List order. **Management reserves the right to limit the number of Dressage rides per horse per day.**

Dressage Freestyle Challenge Specifications: Refer to USEF Subchapter DR 129. Each entry will furnish a cd to be turned into the show officer prior to the beginning of the session containing the Freestyle Challenge and must be marked with the horse's name, entry number, and song number. Please pick up all CD's at the show office. 6 Rides will be allowed.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS:

These shows are conducted in accordance with the rules of the USEF, Arabian Horse Division. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. Any changes or corrections of the rules will be automatically become part of this premium list. Each participant in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. Exhibitors are encouraged to read the USEF Rule book, and particularly the complete Arabian and Half-Arabian Horse rules, class descriptions and judging specifications. The show committee will decide questions not covered by the USEF Rules, and its decision will be final.

A/HA/AA Warm Up Class: Open to all riders. Horses may be shown in Training Equipment and are to be shown at a Walk, Trot/Jog and Canter. This class will not be judged and no ribbons will be awarded.

Liberty Class Specifications:

Horses to be judged on performance, movement, type, presence, and animation. Handler will lead the horse to a designated marker and remove halter. Time and music will start when the halter is removed. While at liberty the horse may perform any gait. Any horse performing any tricks or acts under the apparent control/command of the handler will be disqualified. Only 2 handlers are permitted and each may carry an approved halter whip. Horse is not to be stood up at halter before being turned loose. Time expires after 2 minutes and horse will be eliminated if not caught in a further 2 minutes. Each entry will furnish a CD to be turned in at the show office prior to the beginning of the session containing the Liberty class and must be marked with the horse's name, entry number, and song number. Please pick up all CDs at the show office.

AHA Medal Class Specifications

AHA Hunter Seat Over Obstacles Medal class.

a. To be shown over a course of not fewer than six obstacles with fence heights of 2'6" to 3' of which must include an oxer and two changes of direction (changes of lead).

b. Two or more tests of the top four contestants are required from USEF Equitation Division EQ 113 - Tests 1 -7, 9-15, 17-19 (EC equivalent).

AHA Saddle Seat Medal class.

a. In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF Tests (EQ 120) 1-15 (EC equivalent). Markers shall not be used. USEF Test 16 may only be called for at the National Shows.

AHA Reining Seat Medal class.

a. All contestants are required to perform a Reining pattern as outlined in USEF Reining Division (EC equivalent).

b. Order of go will be done by draw.

c. Bits must be dropped and inspected by the Judge or designated official, and all riders must dismount for this inspection. If called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary, may be had from one of the ring officials.

d. Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits.

e. In the event the total score is tied, the tie will first be broken by the exhibitor with the highest equitation score. Should a tie still exist, the tie shall be broken by reining rules in RN 103.2.

f. It is mandatory that judges use the prescribed AHA Score Sheet for Reining Seat Equitation and that the score sheet or a copy be posted immediately after each class.

AHA Hunter Seat Not to Jump Medal class.

a. In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more tests from USEF Equitation Division, EQ 113. Tests From Which Judges Must Choose.

AHA Western Horsemanship Medal class.

a. In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform a minimum of four tests from USEF Arabian, Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Division, Subchapter Western Horsemanship, AR-26.

ACADEMY Class Specifications: The purpose of this division is to introduce potential new owners to the joys of showing and riding Arabian & Half Arabian horses by giving beginning riders of any breed an opportunity to gain experience by offering beginner classes at our Arabian Class A horse shows.

RIDERS: Riders are encouraged to be in a professionally operated lesson program and to be a member of AHA, with neither being required. Riding suits and chaps are not allowed. Riding pants, jodhpurs, breeches or colored jeans are considered appropriate. A neatly fitted shirt or top is suggested. A riding helmet is also mandatory for riders 10 and under and suggested for all ages. Appropriate footwear with a small heel is mandatory. **Riders are NOT allowed to cross enter into any non-academy riding classes**, and are ineligible to compete in ACADEMY classes once they have shown in a full riding suit or in a Class A Arabian horse show.

HORSES: Horses are encouraged to be lesson horses of any breed and should display the characteristics of such, but it is not mandatory that they are utilized by in a professional lesson—all horses are welcome, as long as they display good manners and a quiet disposition. A cut-back saddle for saddle seat, western saddle for stock seat, and hunt saddle for hunt seat are to be used. Work bridles and bits, including snaffles, are allowed, and running martingales are permitted and encouraged. However, tie down martingales are not allowed. Any horse or rider that is deemed unsafe or is not abiding by these rules may be eliminated by the horse show management.

ACADEMY entries are to follow horse show rules but are not AHA or USEF sanctioned classes. Show grooming is permitted, but not necessary as HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED.

JUDGING: All academy classes are to be judged on the ability of the rider to control and show their horse to its best advantage, and upon the riding skills of the rider. Each class should be judged on the rider's basic equitation and horsemanship skills suited to the class discipline, with emphasis placed on the rider's ability to control the horse at all times, identify correct diagonals and leads promptly, and to control their horses rate in a consistent manner. Riders should convey the impression of good posture, balance, and effective control while commanding proper speed of gaits and show ring placement. Headers are allowed in the line up in all walk-trot classes. HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED, only the rider's ability to control themselves and their horses and present themselves to their best advantage.

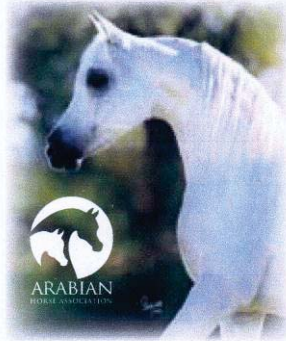

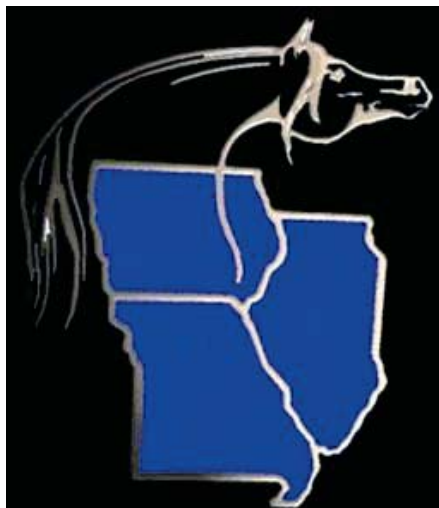
