Groundwork is the foundation for horse and rider. A lot of our riding issues start from the ground and work their way into the saddle. With a solid foundation we can ride with clear communication between horse and rider.

Riding is enhanced with communication and positive experiences between horse and rider. An explanation of timing and clear isolation of pressure points will be demonstrated through exercises that enhance rider's thoughts and expectations, leading to clear understanding for the horse.

Kyla has had the opportunity to train with several clinicians in the natural horsemanship field including Brent Graef, Bryan Neubert and Mark Schwarm. Her training philosophy emphasizes working with the horse, in its current condition, and creating overall improvement with timing and balance. She improves the horse's confidence with positive experiences. Kyla is also certified in equine assisted psychotherapy and learning.
