## 4-H and FFA Horse Show

HORSE SHOW COMMITTEE: Chairman: Kara Wilkerson

This horse show is open state-wide to 4-H and FFA members in good standing who are enrolled in horse or exploring projects. However, premium monies will be paid to only those exhibitors from reciprocating counties.

### **Eligibility to Enter:**

- 1) Proof that the exhibitor is enrolled in the horse project.
- 2) A copy of horse enrollment form with appropriate signatures
- 3) A negative Coggins is required; out of state horses must have current official certificate of Veterinarian inspection (within 30 days). These papers must be presented upon entry.
- 4) NO STALLIONS may be shown

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1) An exhibitor may show only once per class
- 2) A horse may be shown only once per class
- 3) All exhibitors and horses must be in one judged class, excluding costume before participating in any game class.
- 4) Exhibitors may enter one (1) showmanship and one (1) horsemanship class in each discipline.
- 5) First year Horsemanship walk/trot may only show in walk/trot classes (May not show in class #5)
- 6) All exhibitors must wear boots and long-sleeved collared shirts in all classes excluding game classes.
- 7) Helmets must be worn by all contestants in all timed events classes Helmets are optional for all other classes. English helmets are required in English classes.
- 8) Showmanship and Horsemanship classes are judged 75% on horsemanship; 25% on the performance of the horse
- 9) Small classes may be judged at the same time
- 10) Humane bats are permitted behind the girth in timed events.
- 11) Nose tie-downs permitted in game classes only.
- 12) Costume class exhibitors must have a handler who is 14 years or older
