## Non ASHA Sanctioned Classes

### Limited Open/Non Pro Cowhorse Division

The Limited Open Cowhorse class will be run under the same rules as Limited Non-Pro and Green Horse Cowhorse. Any horse/rider combination that does not show in the Open or Non-Pro Working Cowhorse is eligible. Points for this class do not count toward the Highpoint awards in the Open and Non-Pro divisions

### 2-3 year old Division

The 2-3 year old pleasure, reining, trail and cowhorse will be run under the same rules as the novice division. Two & three year old horses that do not show in any other working cowhorse class will be eligible. Separate classes for open and non-pro riders may be held.

### Herd Work See Entry Form Contestants must pre-enter this class

Will use NRCHA or FQHR rules. Any horse is eligible. Open and Non-Pro classes may be offered

### FQHR Classes Held within ASHA Classes

Trail, reining, working cow horse and limited working cowhorse exhibitors can choose to enter both as an ASHA or FQHR sanctioned or either. (FQHR Limited WCH will show in ASHA Novice Working Cowhorse) if both then points will be earned for both associations. If FQHR only then FQHR only and points will be based on those horses. Likewise for ASHA points then points will be based on those horses only. For FQHR classes horses will be required to be registered with FQHR and exhibitor will need a current FQHR membership. For ASHA horses will need to be licensed with ASHA and exhibitor and owner will need a current ASHA membership.
