<p><u>CLASS DIVISIONS</u> <i>(Breakdown, unless noted differently for the class)</i> -Lead Line - Beginner rider and Therapeutic - 8 and Under Walk Trot- Age as of Jan. 1, 2018 - Open Walk Trot-Beginner rider over 8 or green horse - 18 and Under- Walk, trot, lope -Adult 19 and Up- Walk, trot, lope * If you are entered in a walk trot class, you will be placed at the bottom of the class in judged classes and receive a 30 second penalty in timed classes for riders who lope three strides in walk trot classes. ** One person may not enter a walk trot class and use the same horse in a walk trot lope class the same show. You may not enter the lead line division and enter any other division in the same show.</p>	<p>**If you are a CVR Member and attend 3 shows you will be eligible for yearend awards (membership forms can be found at http://cedarvalleyriders.tripod.com/id10.html). RULES:

- **THESE ARE FUN SHOWS.** The goal is to learn with your horse and grow as a rider and horseman throughout the year while having fun. Good sportsmanship will be expected from everyone on the grounds.
- These are equine only fun shows
- Class Divisions -(Breakdown, unless noted differently for the class) Age as of Jan. 1, 2018
 - Lead Line - Beginner rider and Therapeutic- Walk Trot
 - 8 and Under Walk Trot
 - Open Walk Trot- Beginner rider over 8 or green horse
 - 18 and Under- Walk, trot, lope
 - Adult 19 and Up- Walk, trot, lope
- If you are entered in a walk trot class, you will be placed at the bottom of the class in judged classes and receive a 30 second penalty in timed classes for riders who lope three strides in walk trot classes.
 - ****** One person may not enter a walk trot class and use the same horse in a walk trot lope class the same show. You may not enter the lead line division and enter any other division in the same show.
 - *******A rider may only cross enter divisions if they are riding different horses in the divisions (for example adult class on one horse and open walk trot/green horse on a different horse)
- There is not a dress code, but participants must have on jeans and boots; button down long sleeve shirts and a hat are not required but may effect the judges decisions for the judged classes
- The judge's decision is final, there will be 5 placing awarded with ribbons in all classes including lead line. The class will be placed all the way out for all persons in the class so that points can be accumulated to for yearend awards for members.
- Patterns for classes requiring them and additional information will be posted on Cedar Valley Riders Facebook Page and the Cedar Valley Riders Fun Show Series Group on Facebook before the shows. (Showmanship, Horsemanship, Trail, Reining)
- ****Patterns may be adjusted the day of the show at the judge's discretion****
- Splish Splash will be for the lead line and 8 and under class only, entries will have to hold a cup of water while they ride around the pen, going through the maneuvers as they are called out and the one with the most water in the cup at the end of the class wins
- Pairs Class is entered two horse and rider teams one class entry fee, the class is judged on horse and rider teams that match the closest and accurately preform the required maneuvers through out the class.
- Mounted Dummy Roping will require you to ride down and rope a hay bale with a steer head in it, you must catch legal head catch – slick horns, half head or neck, drop the rope and go back across the time line. Three loop limit
- Snowy river race / Jousting- use a jousting stick and ride around the pen and joust rings attached to poles overhanging the pen
- Jackpot classes will be following the conclusion of the show classes of all divisions.

- ****AS A MEMBER OF CEDAR VALLEY RIDERS SADDLE CLUB****
- If you attend 3 shows you will be eligible for yearend awards. We will have awards for everyone who participated in three shows. There will be high point awards given to the high point in each division and additional prizes as the years income allows. Prizes will increase in quality and quantity the more participation and money generated throughout the year.
- Please refrain from bringing foals- if necessary make sure they are haltered to lead
- There will be no horses tied in the entry and exit gate areas, and ask that you do not hold horses by the gate during classes either. Find a place to tie or hold horses not in the class entering or exiting the arena out of the way, this will help shows run smoother and be safer for all participants.
- Dogs need to be on a leash
- This is a great place for people of all ages and experience levels to come and enjoy friendships old and new! We want to make sure that this is possible at each and every show.
 - If a rider is unable to control their horse or it is a danger to others in a class, you may be excused from the class. If the behavior continues outside of the arena show staff may excuse you from the grounds.
 - As horsemen we will experience all types of riders, Equine (Mares, Stallions etc.), and lots of uncalculated accidents and obstacles we understand that things happen but still wish to keep the safety of all in mind.
