

The Friday, April 20th show starts at 5 pm sharp! The draw will be at 4:20 for the 1000 Nov horse/1st class. Cattle will be settled at 4:30.

There will be a practice on Friday starting at noon. Horses arriving earlier are welcome. The practice will end at 4pm, no exceptions for late arrivals.

There will be a round of AQHA shows on Friday and 2 sets of AQHA shows on Saturday, April 21 (there will also be 3 more sets of AQHA shows in May).

The AQHA Senior horses will run in the NCHA OPEN, the JR horses (5 years and under) will run in the 5000 Novice, and the Amateur class will run in the Non-Pro. You will only pay an additional \$30 total (office & drug fee) to show for AQHA points in these classes as long as you are entered in the corresponding NCHA class.

There will be an additional AQHA AMATEUR stand alone class on Saturday (only). \$30 office + \$30 rerun cattle charge.

The fresh cattle classes for both days will be the 1000 Novice Horse (1st class), Open, 5000 Nov, NonPro and 25 Nov.

\$50 jackpot + 20 office + \$60 CC. Practice fresh works will be \$60 for 2 fresh cows / \$25 for reruns. You must email your fresh entries for these classes and practice by close of day on Wednesday, April 18 to - [fbarf111@gmail.com](mailto:fbarf111@gmail.com)
