

## Registration Information

**Horses must be in the care of the 4-H or FFA member by May 1st. The horse shall not have been professionally trained or shown by anyone other than the 4-H member after May 1.**

1. All Lewis County 4-H & FFA entries must be pre-registered.
2. Only one entry may be made in each class. In order to participate in Game Classes, members must show in Showmanship at Halter.
3. All events are governed by Missouri State 4-H Horsemanship Rules, including dress code.
4. All exhibitors must wear western attire for all classes except the Costume Class.
5. Horses **MUST** be kept in designated areas. **Absolutely NO riding or leading out of marked area.**
6. **Coggins Test is REQUIRED on ALL horses. Proof of negative test must be turned in prior to show.**
7. All exhibitors participating in game classes **MUST** wear an (ASTM/SEI) Equine Helmet. 4-H Council may have (2) helmets available that can be used by exhibitors upon request.
8. All Lewis Co. 4-H & FFA members must have all horses registered with the Lewis County Extension Office by May 1st, if they wish to use that horse in the Lewis Co. 4-H & FFA Horse Show. Out of county entries must have all valid horse enrollment forms on file in their respective counties. Valid 4-H Horse Enrollment forms and Coggins papers must be presented at check in before the show.

9. Exhibiting 4-H & FFA members are the only persons allowed to be on their horse once on the fairgrounds.
10. **We are not responsible for accident or injury to any non 4-H horsemanship member or leader.**
11. Premiums will be paid to 4-H & FFA members enrolled in Lewis County programs only.
12. AQHA reining pattern #6 will be used for Reining. A copy of this may be obtained at the Lewis County Extension Office upon request.
13. **Novice participants (1st & 2nd yr. members) will only show in Novice level classes.**
