- Ranch horses may cross enter into any other classes.
- Anyone may enter in a buckle challenge class regardless of age, division, or what classes they are competing in- anything goes, but all tack must be legal.

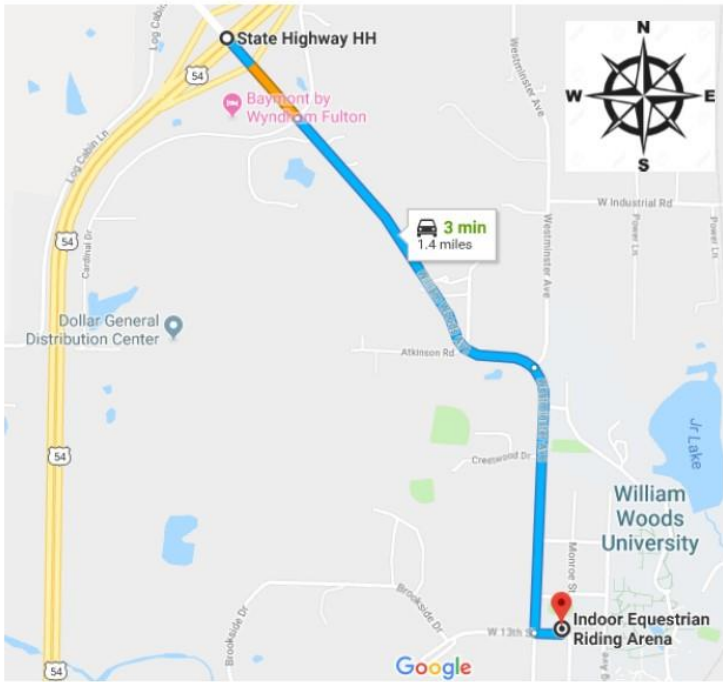
